Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Steve Foot – Chief Coach or Claire Foot – Club Secretary.

As a member of Dorking Freestyle Sport Karate you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- All members must train within the rules and respect club officials/referees and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, age, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit – *Club T shirt & Trousers plus protective equipment to include Headguard, Gumshield, Gloves, Shin Guards, Boots, Box or Chest Guard* – for training sessions and competitive events, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Members must pay any fees for training or additional events promptly.
- Members are not permitted to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Members are not permitted to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
